Students are required to complete approximately 8 hours of self-paced online pre-course work prior to the first day of class. The 10-week course of instruction will begin Monday January 24, 2022, with one week of classroom instruction followed by one week of facilitated distance learning. Students will have at least a two week break prior to the next two weeks of instruction. The course schedule is:

June 6 - 10, 2022	Distance Learning
June 13 - 17, 2022	Classroom Learning
